

## INSTALLATIONS

It's located in an incomparable setting, surrounded by an exuberant vegetation, on the banks of the majestic river Amazon and it's 40 kilometres away from Iquitos, the capital city of this Amazonian region. The lodge has been built with typical materials from this area, always trying to preserve the native customs and traditions. Wood and palm leaves (*crisnejas*), are the basis for this building, which is completely risen up from the ground.

It consists of a main house where one will find the reception, the dining room and the bar. It's completely prepared to look after the visitors, offering them all kind of comforts and services in order to make their stay be most nice and amusing . They will be delighted with international and regional food as well as exotic and suggestive drinks. In one of our gardens, you will find a pleasant site with hammocks and a viewpoint, an ideal place to relax and rest from this place one can observe the wonderful dawns which this forest landscape gives us as a pleasure while we can see the Amazon with its fast and constant course.

The access to the rooms which are situated in five different cabins, there are two marital and eight double rooms, is through high grounded and covered passages, being large, with private bathroom and balconies and they afford a superb view overlooking the river and the jungle. Each house takes the name of a different native Amazonian population, they are decorated with traditional craftwork, being typical of the diverse ethnic groups.

The lodge has completely channeled the drainage system and the water supply, though this last one is not fit for public consumption. It's just used in bathrooms, showers and for the washing service.

The rest of the building consists of a warehouse, laundry and kitchen, and obviously the typical *THUSPA*, where our expert cook will prepare delicious meals for these with a discerning palate, meals cooked following the traditions of the settlers of this area.

The guides who are native people and great experts on the region, will offer the passengers diverse and interesting trips, where they will be shown the exuberant landscape, the flora and fauna, medicinal plants, customs and beliefs of its inhabitants. The passenger will enjoy himself and he will go into the deepest secrets of this wonderful and bewitching world thanks to our guides' nice and dynamic explanations, where both legends and traditional stories become intermingle.

All our staff are prepared to meet the most demanding requests and to offer the best service and the fullest attention in order to make the visitors nicely remember their stay at our installations in this suggestive Amazonian spot.

## PACKS

### **"A"** Knowing the Surroundings (2 days/ 1 night)

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Day**

- Picking up at the airport and moving to the lodge.
- Reception and welcoming cocktail.
- Guidance and putting the visitors up in their rooms.
- Long walk and visit to a riverside community.
- Lunch and rest.
- Visit to a sugar mill where you will see the traditional extraction of the sugar cane juice. It will be possible, according to the passenger's wish, to visit a snake breeder of the zone.
- Return to the lodge, where a short trip on foot or by canoe (depending on the season) will be made to listen to the symphony of sounds the forest gives us during the night.
- Dinner. Relax time, when the passenger will be able to savour the exotic drinks of the region and according to the moment, to enjoy our musical performances.

#### **2<sup>nd</sup> Day**

- Weather permitting we will be able to observe, from our installations, a beautiful dawn on the majestic Amazon river.
- Breakfast.

- We will be taken on boat to the “pink dolphins’ sanctuary”, located right opposite the lodge. This species is native to this area and it’s the only place in the world where they can be seen.
- Long walk on a “*chacra*”( typical cultivation place) up to arrive at a pool or “*cocha*” where we will take a canoe to observe the huge aquatic lilies known as “*Victorias Regias*” and to reach the part of low or primary rainforest where we will have the chance to see giant trees, orchids, butterflies, lianas whose delicious and refreshing water we will drink, medicinal plants and perhaps any inhabitant of that land passes by us on the way.
- We will by to fish some piranha on our way back to the lodge.
- Lunch.
- Travel to Iquitos to take the plane.

**"B"** All Jungle around (3 days/ 2 night)

- Return to the lodge.

- Return to the lodge to make a short trip on foot or by canoe (depending on the season) where we will enjoy listening to the wonderful symphony of sounds the forest offers as at night.

From there, we will be heading for *Mazán* , by three-wheeler ran (a typical means of transport) A cheerful and busy community located on the banks of the river *Napo* where we will able to quench our thirst with some refreshing drink. We will go by motorbikes to arrive at *Indiana*. No fear, they are managed by drivers. We will walk along their quiet streets and we will observe the difference between this community and the previous one.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Day

- Breakfast and relax time before the new adventure.
- We will travel down the Amazon river on boat up to arrive at a little jetty called *Baradero*,. From there, we will be heading for *Mazán* , by three-wheeler ran (a typical means of transport).The path runs through a dense forest peppered with little lakes or “*cochas*” containing different kinds of fishes. This is a cheerful and busy community , located on the banks of the river *Napo* and there we will have lunch, without hurrying, enjoying its landscape and its people.
- We will go on crossing the jungle travelling by driven motorbikes up to reach *Indiana*. A community completely different from the previous one. More peaceful and quieter. There our boat will be waiting for us to go on the trip along the river.
- We will be able to observe a new sunset from the magnificent Amazon. And why not to swim, fish or just observe the magic of this scenery.
- Arrival at the lodge to cool ourselves down and rest.
- Dinner.

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- Who feels like knowing a “*chaman*”? Chance to listen to his stories. He will talk about his methods of treatment, his cures, his rites..., and the enigmatic *Ayahuasca*.
- After all those emotions we will deserve a good rest.

### **4<sup>th</sup> Day**
